CRAB RUN SOLAR PROJECT, LLC’S
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO REISSUE NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Comes now Crab Run Solar Project, LLC (“Crab Run Solar” or “Applicant”), by counsel, and respectfully moves the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (“the Board”) for leave to reissue notice pursuant to KRS 278.706(2). Copies of the proposed reissued letter to landowners whose property borders the proposed site and the proposed general public notice for publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county are attached hereto as Exhibits A and B, respectively.

I. FACTUAL BACKGROUND

1. On December 1, 2025, Applicant sent letters notifying landowners whose property borders the proposed site of the forthcoming application, providing the case number to the online docket. See Application, at Tab 3 and Attachment B. On December 10, 2025, public notice of the forthcoming application was published in *The Lebanon Enquirer*, a newspaper of general

circulation in Marion County, Kentucky and likewise contained a citation to the online case docket number. See *id.*

2. The Application was filed on December 19, 2025, and a letter indicating the Application meets the minimum filing requirements and has been accepted was filed on December 23, 2025.

3. Applicant's counsel recently found the letter and notice referenced in Paragraph 1 above inadvertently did not contain language required by 807 KAR 5:110, § 9(3).


4. Applicant therefore so informs the Board and by this Motion requests leave to reissue the letters and newspaper notice with this language included and to allow 30 days from the later of the mailing date of the reissued letter or publication date of the reissued newspaper notice during which Applicant would not object on the basis of timeliness to any requests made pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, §4(1) and/or 807 KAR 5:110, § 8(2).

5. Applicant sought instruction from the Board regarding this procedural matter and files this Motion accordingly.

6. No party will be prejudiced by the granting of this Motion, and no other aspect of the Board's procedural schedule is affected. Indeed, both public fairness and procedural efficiency are served by granting this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Applicant Crab Rub Solar Project, LLC respectfully requests the Board grant this Motion and provide leave for letters and the newspaper notice in the form attached as Exhibits A and B to be sent/published.

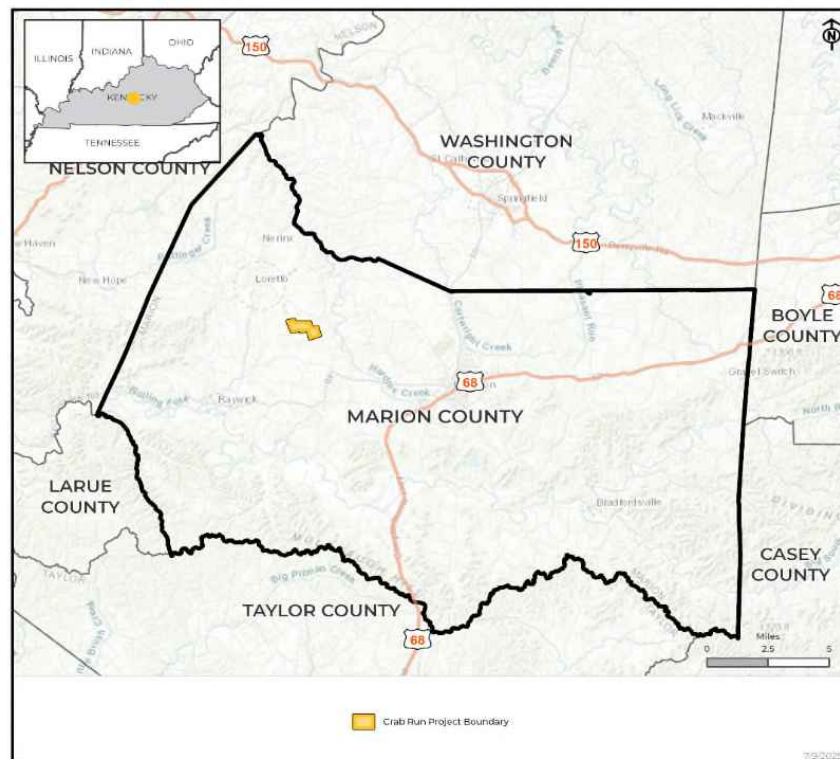

As the attorneys representing Crab Run Solar Project, LLC (“Crab Run”) before the Kentucky Electric Generation and Transmission Siting Board (“Siting Board”), we are writing to inform you that Crab Run filed an application with the Siting Board in Case No. 2025-00276.

Crab Run is proposing to develop and construct an up to 45-megawatt solar electric generating facility on approximately 400 acres of privately owned land located in Marion County, Kentucky. The proposed project is not located on your property. You are receiving this letter because your property is within the vicinity of the proposed project, and under state law, we are required to notify everyone in the vicinity as part of the state siting application process.

The proposed project will consist of approximately 110,052 photovoltaic solar panels and associated racking, approximately 12 inverters, a project substation transformer, and other necessary equipment to support the project. A map of the project area is provided below:

Crab Run's application is subject to the Siting Board's review and approval. The contact information for the Siting Board is as follows: P.O. Box 615, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602-0615, or by telephone at (502) 564-3940.

A person who wishes to become a party to a proceeding before the board may, by written motion filed no later than thirty (30) days after the date hereof, request leave to intervene. An evidentiary hearing has been scheduled for April 28, 2026 at the offices of the Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky. A request for a local public hearing or local public information meeting shall be made by at least three (3) interested persons who reside in the county or municipal corporation in which the proposed project is to be located. The request shall be made in writing and shall be filed within thirty (30) days following the date hereof.

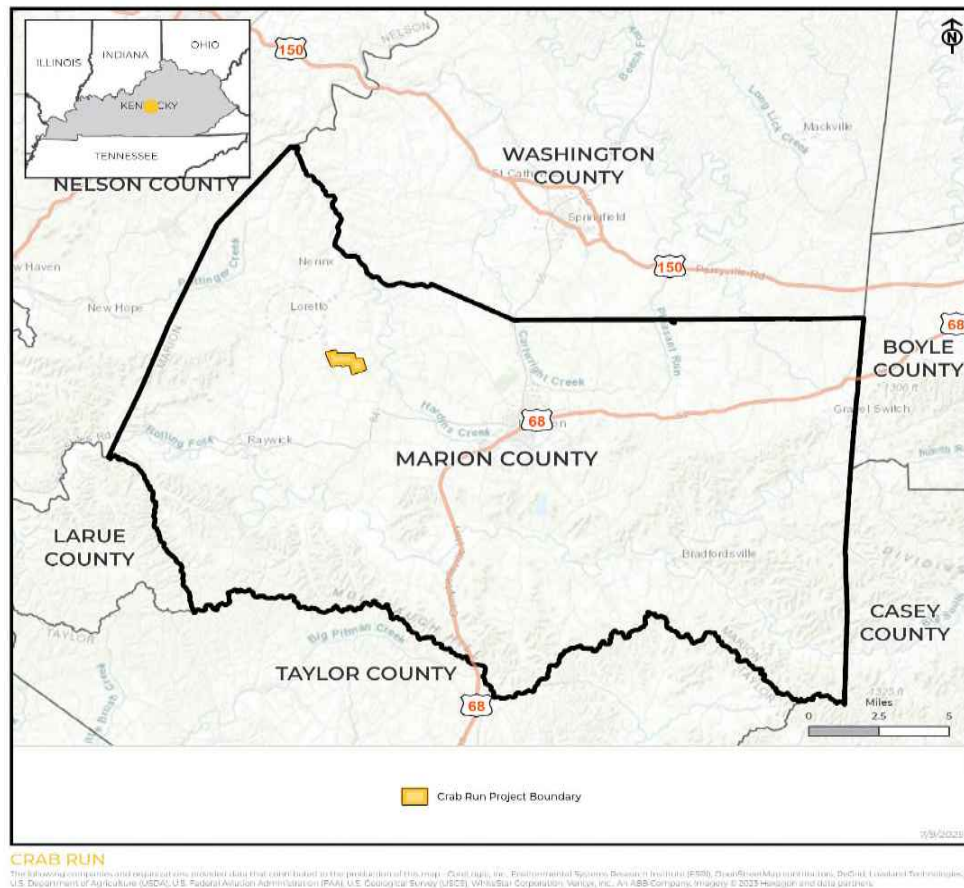
