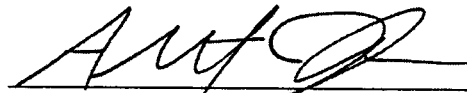


CITY OF EARLINGTON'S NOTICE TO INVOKE

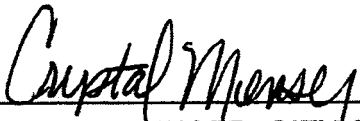
