The meeting was called to order by Mayor Epley.

DELTA REGIONAL GRANT – Commissioner Marsh made a motion to advertise for bids for the Delta Regional Grant for the project on Millstone Way. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW STREET NAME FOR PUD ROAD OFF MEMORIAL DRIVE – This subject will be tabled until the regular commission meeting on April 29, 2025, to give the commissioners time to think about a name to vote on.

ADD ADDITIONAL SIGNATURE TO CHECKING ACCOUNTS – Commissioner Marsh made A motion to add Assistant City Clerk, Christie Rainwater to the signature cards for all accounts at Independence Bank. This is for her to be able to sign checks in the event the Mayor or City Clerk are unavailable to sign. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

INVOKE WASTEWATER RATE ADJUSTMENT – Commissioner Marsh made a motion to allow the mayor authorization to sign a “Notice to Invoke the Wastewater rate adjustment” to the City of Madisonville. Commissioner Oakley seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

CLOSED SESSION PERSONNEL AND LITIGATION – Commissioner Marsh made a motion to go into closed session to discuss a matter with personnel and a matter concerning litigation. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion.

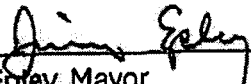
Commissioner Epley made a motion to go back into the open session. Commissioner Marsh seconded the motion.

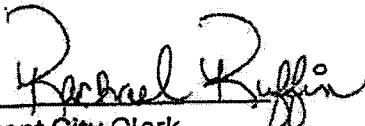
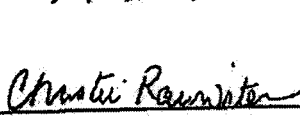
No action taken on the matter of personnel. No action taken on the matter regarding litigation.
