This is an application to add a non-recurring charge for Caldwell County Water District. Attached is the proposed new tariff.

The District is not requesting a water rate increase at this time. However, increased cost attributable to the non-recurring charge can no longer be absorbed by the District. The customers affected by the charge will be the customers that cause the District to incur the additional expense.

The additional revenue generated from the proposed tariff revisions does not exceed by five (5) percent the total revenues provided by all miscellaneous and non-recurring charges for a recent twelve (12) month period. The District has previously filed income statements and balance sheets with the Public Service Commission that are currently on file with the Commission.

The District will publish the enclosed public notice of the requested rate revisions in the local newspaper for three consecutive weeks. We will follow up with an affidavit from the newspaper verifying that the notice was published once a week for three consecutive weeks

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given that Caldwell County Water District ("District") plans to file with the Public Service Commission on or before September 10, 2025 to add a non-recurring charge. The proposed effective date is October 10, 2025. The proposed addition is as follows:

Damage to Meter/Setter/Lid/Antenna Will be assessed when a customer maliciously, willfully, or negligently breaks, damages, destroys, uncovers, defaces, or tampers with any structure, appurtenance, or equipment which is part of the District's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to disconnection of water service and shall pay the cost of repairing or replacing the appurtenances as may be determined by a court of law having jurisdiction.

Any damage will be charged to the responsible party at the actual cost incurred by the District.

Any person may examine this tariff filing at the District office located at 118 West Market Street, Princeton, KY 42445; telephone (270) 365-9381.

Any person may examine this tariff filing at the PSC located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday - Friday, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm or on the PSC website at http://psc.ky.gov; telephone (502) 564-3940.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the District, but the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing

- F. Customer Complaints to the Utility: Upon complaint to the utility by a customer at the utility's office, by telephone, or in writing, the utility will make a prompt and complete investigation and advise the complainant of its findings. The utility's operator/manager will make a decision within ten (10) days, which the complainant will then have ten (10) days to appeal to the utility's board of commissioners. The customer will receive a final decision from the utility no later than thirty (30) days following the date that the complaint was made. If the complainant is not satisfied with the utility's decision, the utility will provide written notice to the complainant of his/her right to appeal the utility's decision by filing a complaint with the Public Service Commission. The utility will also provide the customer with the address and telephone number of the Public Service Commission. The utility will keep a record of all written complaints. This record will show the name and address of the complainant, the date and nature of the complaint, and the adjustment or disposition of the complaint. Records will be maintained for two (2) years from the date of resolution of the complaint.
- G. <u>Damge to Meter/Setter/Lid/Antenna:</u> Will be assessed when a customer maliciously, willfully, or negligently breaks, damages, destroys, uncovers, defaces, or tampers with any structure, appurtenance, or equipment which is part of the District's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to disconnection of water service and shall pay the cost of repairing or replacing the appurtenances as may be determined by a court of law having jurisdiction.

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
