Kentucky Power Company's Request To Submit Matter For Decision On The Record

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky's (the "Commission") September 26, 2025 Order, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power" or the "Company") respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record and without a hearing. In support of its Request, Kentucky Power states as follows:

The Commission opened this case and issued its procedural schedule by order dated September 26, 2025 (the "Procedural Schedule"). The Procedural Schedule set the last day to intervene in this case as October 7, 2025. As of the date of this filing, no parties have requested nor have any parties been granted leave to intervene. In conformity with the Procedural Schedule, Kentucky Power submitted its responses to Commission Staff's first set of data requests on November 5, 2025. No other data requests have been filed. The only milestones remaining on the Procedural Schedule are related to intervenor testimony and discovery to intervenors.

The Procedural Schedule provides that Kentucky Power may request a hearing or to submit this matter for a decision on the record by January 5, 2026. Given that there are no intervenors in this case, the remaining deadlines in the Procedural Schedule have become moot. Therefore, Kentucky Power respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record as of the date of this filing.

However, the Company will defer to the Commission if the Commission or Commission Staff determine that a hearing is needed or would be beneficial to supplement the record of this matter with additional evidence. In that event, the Company would be amenable to making its witnesses available for any such hearing at the convenience of the Commission. The Company also is willing to attend an informal conference with Commission Staff to discuss any outstanding issues, any evidence submitted, or to discuss any other matters that would aid in the handling and disposition of the case.
