Please let this letter serve as notice, pursuant to KRS 278.020, 807 KAR 5:001 and 807 KAR 5:120 that East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”) plans to file on or after October 19, 2025 an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) to construct a 161 kV electric transmission line in Pulaski County, Kentucky and for other general relief. This project is necessary to provide transmission service for newly approved generation assets and will allow EKPC to continue to provide safe and reliable service to its Owner-Members and their end-use members. It will also add additional transmission capacity for future load growth in the area.


