MOTION TO SUBMIT

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by and through counsel, pursuant to the October 30, 2025 Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and other applicable law, and requests this case be submitted for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing, respectfully state as follows:

1. On October 7, 2025, EKPC filed this Application for approval of authority to issue up to \$1,000,000,000 in private placement or financial institution debt; the execution of precedent agreements; and, for the use of interest rate management instruments.
2. The Commission issued a procedural schedule for the processing of this matter. The procedural schedule included two requests for information to EKPC. On November 17, 2025, Commission Staff issued its First Request for Information and EKPC provided responses on December 1, 2025. Commission Staff did not issue a subsequent request for information.

3. The October 30, 2025 Order allowed the parties to request a hearing on or before January 5, 2026. EKPC believes based on the Application and the responses to requests for information, the issues have been adequately addressed through written discovery. EKPC does not believe a formal evidentiary hearing is necessary, and moves to submit the case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record without a formal evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully moves to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.
