**EDMONSON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT'S
RESPONSE AND CLARIFICATION TO MEMORANDUM**

Edmonson County Water District (“Edmonson District”) submits this Response and Clarification to the Memorandum of Virtual Informal Conference held on July 15, 2026. The Memorandum was filed and served on Edmonson District on July 21, 2026.

Edmonson District hereby responds to clarify information regarding the grant funding for certain planned future projects. The Memorandum contains the statement that “Edmonson District confirmed that they have received several federal grants over the past few years including a federal grant in 2026 in the amount of approximately \$30 million.” In fact, as explained during the informal conference, and as set out in written testimony by Edmonson District’s General Manager Daniel Brown¹ and the 2025 Annual Report filed by Edmonson District with the Commission, the grants and earmarks Edmonson District has received include both state and federal funds. Specifically, they are as follows:

- Monies from House Bill 1 grants received during the 2024 *Kentucky* legislative session, which Edmonson District intends to use for a connection to Warren County Water District’s system that is estimated to cost about \$6,000,000.

- An earmark of \$14 million received as a result of the 2026 *federal* budget, which Edmonson District intends to use to redesign and update the raw water intake for the District's Brownsville water treatment plant.
- An earmark of \$9,500,000 received as a result of the 2026 *federal* budget, which Edmonson District intends to use to update the District's Brownsville water treatment plant.

Daniel Brown's written testimony (cited in footnote 1 above) contains additional information about the scope and need for these planned future projects and is incorporated herein by reference.
