To all customers of Edmonson County Water District. In early 2024 the Board of the Edmonson County Water District set out to complete a deep dive long term assessment of the condition of the Edmonson County Water District infrastructure and assets. It's finding brought to light that one of the most challenging struggles was the capacity of available treated water to the customers between the two treatment plants. An original study conducted by HMB Engineering of Frankfort Ky. Generated a plan to consolidate both plants into one and locate a new treatment plant somewhere on Nolin Lake in the center of the entire service area. This project estimate became so large that economically it had too significant of a financial impact on all of the Water District customers.

When looking at alternative supplies of water sources from surrounding Water Systems and asking if they had surplus water resources it was found that excess capacity was limited at best and very difficult to move to the more needed areas of the Edmonson system. However, what did come from these conversations was that two neighboring systems Green River Valley Water District (GRVWD) & Grayson County Water District (GCWD) did have the abilities to supply the resources needed of treated water and personnel to the customers of the two counties that each of them served separately. GRVWD to the Hart County customers & GCWD to the customers served in Grayson County by Edmonson County Water District.

After much deliberation and evaluating different scenarios, we have come to a conclusion that in the best interest of all the customers of the Edmonson County Water District the best decision would be to negotiate an arrangement where the GRVWD will begin serving the customers in Hart County that is served by Edmonson Water and GCWD to begin serving the customers served by Edmonson

Water in Grayson County. While we do not take this decision lightly, we genuinely believe in this decision.

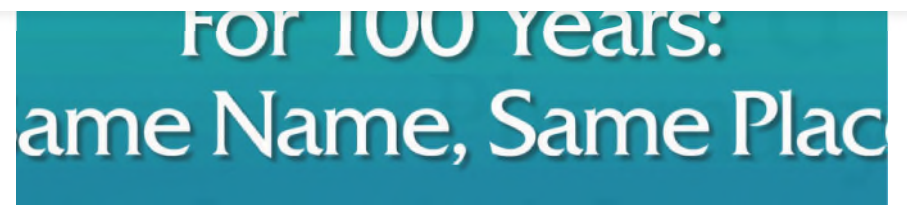

Nearly 5000 Grayson & Hart County Customers to Be Transferred to Other Providers

The Edmonson County Water District announced today that nearly 5,000 district customers outside of Edmonson County will be transferred to other water service providers.

In a statement provided to the Edmonson Voice, the ECWD said that in early 2024 the Board of the Edmonson County Water District set out to complete a long term

The ECWD further stated that after much deliberation and evaluating different scenarios, the best interest of all the customers of the Edmonson County Water District would be to negotiate an arrangement where the GRVWD will begin serving the customers in Hart County that is served by Edmonson Water and GCWD to begin serving the customers served by Edmonson Water in Grayson County.

"I really feel like this is a good decision," said ECWD General Manager Kevin Shaw. "We

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Shaw said that Edmonson County residents will see no impact on the decision.

"Our Hart and Grayson County customers should see no interruption in their water service but we ask for your patience as we transfer documentation and billing information to the new providers."

Shaw said he hopes for a smooth transaction for out-of-county customers and they are working to make it as efficient as possible.

Shaw also said there will be some slight exceptions to the decision. The ECWD services just a few Warren and Butler County customers, but they will NOT be affected by this move. They will remain as ECWD customers. Additionally, there will be a customer here and there in Hart and Grayson Counties that will also remain, depending on exactly where you fall along the county lines. Customers affected will be contacted further.

According to the ECWD, it is anticipated that beginning July 1st, 2025, Hart County customers will begin using the GRVWD office as their new point of contact and the Grayson County customers will begin using the GCWD office as their new point of contact beginning August 1st; however, the ECWD said that these are projected dates, only, and the final date will be shared in various ways as the dates become closer.

In addition, as EC rates are slightly lower than the other two providers, all rates will continue to be billed at the current approved rates as currently published by the Edmonson County Water District until complete approval by the Kentucky Public Service commission and all other federal and State agencies involved have officially approved the transition, according to the water district.

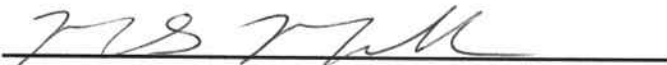

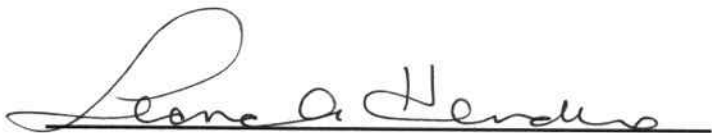

The work will generally be in the Nolin Lake area of Grayson County but the need may arise to have the contractor work anywhere in the GCWD distribution system. GCWD would like the contractor to provide a minimum of the following information in the quote:

- Laborer per hour
- Equipment Operator per hour
- Track hoe per hour
- Back hoe per hour
- Mini track per hour
- Dump truck per hour
- Installation of water service on a short side (same side of Rd as water main)
- Installation of water service on a long side (opposite side of Rd as water main)
- Installation of a 3" flush hydrant (including typical concrete kicker)
- Installation of a 5.25" fire hydrant (including typical concrete kicker)

The contractor is responsible to provide all labor and equipment needed to perform the work. All parts and supplies needed for work will be supplied by the water district per project. The Leitchfield City Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at the Leitchfield City Hall, 515 South Main Street, Leitchfield, Kentucky on Monday, July 14th, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. to receive public comments on a proposal to amend the text of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Leitchfield pursuant to KRS 100.211.

The proposed text amendments are as follows:

2.11 ZONING TEXT AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this Ordinance shall be performed in the same manner as adoption of the original Ordinance and in conformance with Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 100, with a minimum of two public hearings, the first held by the Planning Commission, and the second to be published and held by the City Council:

Zoning text amendments shall be performed as set out in KRS 100.211(2) and specifically:

"(2) A proposal to amend the text of any zoning regulation which must be voted upon by the legislative body or fiscal court may originate with the planning commission of the unit or with any fiscal court or legislative body which is a member of the unit. Regardless of the origin of the proposed amendment, it shall be referred to the planning commission before adoption. The planning commission shall hold at least one (1) public hearing after notice as required by KRS Chapter 424 and make a recommendation as to the text of the amendment and whether the amendment shall be approved or disapproved and shall state the reasons for its recommendation. In the case of a proposed amendment originating with a legislative body or fiscal court, the planning commission shall make its recommendation within sixty (60) days of the date of its receipt of the proposed amendment. It shall take an affirmative vote of a majority of the fiscal court or legislative body to adopt the proposed amendment."

Beginning August 1st, 2025, the Grayson County Water District will be serving as your public water utility. The Grayson County Water District has agreed to purchase the portion of Edmonson County's system that is in Grayson County along with a small portion that is in Edmonson County. The Grayson County Water District will begin managing that portion of the system under an operating agreement with the plan to take full ownership in the next year. August 1st, 2025, is a **projected and planned date** that could be adjusted as needed based on the work ahead of both systems and getting prepared for the change in operations.

What does this mean to you as a customer inside this territory?

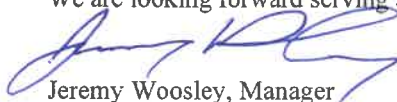
Billing: The Edmonson County Water District will get a final reading for your ECWD account in July and will send your final bill in August. Your deposit with ECWD will be refunded on to your account with ECWD. Any and all questions about your final ECWD bill or your ECWD deposit will need to be directed to ECWD. Your first bill from GCWD will come in September. There will be no overlaps in billing or readings between ECWD and GCWD. At this time no deposit with GCWD will be required for customers transferring to GCWD from ECWD.

Service: Starting August 1st, 2025, you will contact GCWD for any issues related to your water utility service or any new services in that territory. You can contact us via phone at (270)259-2917, via email at gcwd@graysonwater.com or feel free to check out our website at www.graysonwater.com. We are located at 21 Shull White Rd., Leitchfield, KY 42754.

Rates and Fees: There will be no changes to rates and fees in this territory until the Public Service Commission has approved the purchase agreement between GCWD and ECWD. That is expected to come sometime in the next year. Once approval has been received everyone will move over to GCWD's current rates and fees. At that time a notification will go out to all customers affected by the change.

Payments and Drafts: At GCWD we offer multiple ways to pay (online, via auto draft with card or bank account, in person at our office with cash, check, or card, via phone, via mail, and we have an afterhours night drop available at our office). Unfortunately, your account numbers and any payment or draft information that you currently have with ECWD will not transfer to GCWD. Once you have received your first bill from GCWD in September you will have to contact the GCWD office or go to our online portal to setup any auto draft information. We do use the same online payment portal, Invoice Cloud, as ECWD so that should simplify the transition.

We are looking forward serving as your water utility. Please contact us with any questions.



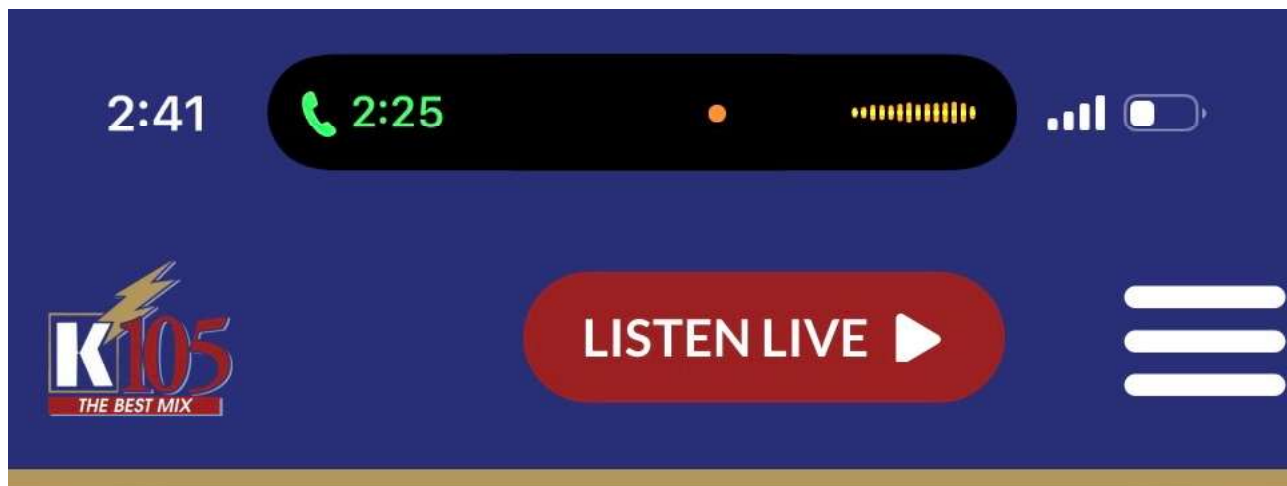

Grayson Co. Water District purchasing Edmonson Co. Water District's assets in Grayson Co.

The Grayson County Water District (GCWD) is in the process of purchasing the Edmonson County Water District's (ECWD) assets in Grayson County.

"In early 2025 the Grayson County Water District was approached by the Edmonson County Water District to inquire if GCWD would be interested in purchasing the customers, infrastructure, and territory of the ECWD that was in Grayson County," according to GCWD official Kyle Cannon.

Since the late 1960s, the ECWD has provided retail water service to approximately 3,500 customers in the southeastern portion of Grayson County, including Anneta, Peonia, Wax, and

Broadford.

But, in recent years, Cannon said the ECWD's "aging water treatment plant and other aging infrastructure caused water quality and water availability issues in those (Grayson Co.) parts of the system and required upgrades to improve those issues made it cost prohibitive to continue serving those areas from ECWD."

The issues faced by the ECWD resulted in officials concluding that the GCWD is a more "cost-effective option" for serving Grayson County customers, Cannon said.

The deal

The purchase price for Grayson County's portion of ECWD's territory is \$4,658,500, according to Cannon. The purchase will be financed through a 1-percent loan for \$7,848,000, which has been approved by the **Kentucky Infrastructure Authority** (KIA).

The remaining funds, Cannon noted, will be used to finance infrastructure upgrades in the territory.

"GCWD has also been approved for loan forgiveness by the KIA in the amount of \$2,784,517, leaving the total outstanding principal at \$5,063,483.

An Asset Purchase agreement was made between the ECWD and GCWD on September 23, 2025.

On October 6, 2025, the agreement was filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) requesting an order to approve the transfer of ownership of ECWD's Grayson County distribution system to GCWD, and an order authorizing the issuance of securities by GCWD to purchase the territory.

The purchase is expected to be approved by the PSC on or about July 1, 2026, as the GCWD and ECWD continue to work with the PSC to obtain approval of the transfer of ownership.

Timeline of transfer process up to the Asset Purchase agreement in Sept. 2025

January 15, 2025: GCWD was approached by ECWD to purchase territory.

February 18, 2025: The GCWD board decided to move forward with negotiations with ECWD for the purchase of the ECWD's territory in Grayson County.

May 25, 2025: The board passed resolutions approving a Statement of Intent to Purchase and an Operating Agreement with ECWD.

May 29, 2025: Both the Operating Agreement and Statement of Intent were fully executed.

June 23, 2025: GCWD was invited by KIA to apply for a low interest loan and grant funding to finance the cost of purchasing ECWD's system in Grayson County, as well as infrastructure upgrades that accompany the project.

August 1, 2025: GCWD began operating the new territory under the operating agreement with ECWD.

August 25, 2025: The board authorized the chairperson to enter into a loan agreement with KIA to finance the purchase and infrastructure upgrades for the new territory.
