**JOINT APPLICANTS’ MOTION
FOR CLARIFICATION AND INFORMAL CONFERENCE**

By and through the undersigned counsel, and pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4), Green River Valley Water District (“Green River Valley District”) and Edmonson County Water District (“Edmonson District”) (collectively “Joint Applicants”) in response to the Commission’s July 2, 2026 Order denying Joint Applicants’ Application without prejudice and consolidating the record of this

proceeding with the record of Case No. 2025-00330,¹ state the following:

1. The Commission's July 2, 2026 Order directs the Joint Applicants to: ". . . further evaluate the financing associated with the proposed transaction, obtain the necessary RD approvals, and to re-file their applications with the appropriate information for the Commission to fully evaluate the proposal."²

2. Given that RD has **not** historically approved debt assumptions until all other regulatory approvals have been obtained, the Joint Applicants respectfully seek clarification concerning what information the Commission would **potentially** find appropriate to fully evaluate a proposal such as the one proposed in this proceeding.

3. Joint Applicants also respectfully request that the Commission schedule an informal conference as soon as practicable so that they can discuss with Commission Staff what information may be required to fully evaluate a proposed transfer.

4. In making this request, Joint Applicants readily acknowledge that Commission Staff cannot speak on behalf of the Commission. The Commission speaks only through its Orders. However, the Joint Applicants would benefit from Commission Staff's opinion as to what information might be appropriate under the

circumstances. This could conserve time and other valuable resources for the Commission as well as the Joint Applicants.

5. Joint Applicants also respectfully clarify that they **have not** proposed that Green River Valley District assume 52 percent of Edmonson District's RD Debt as stated in the Commission's final Order.³ The Joint Applicants have proposed that Green River Valley District assume or satisfy 52 percent of Edmonson District's current indebtedness related to the construction of extensions or improvements to Edmonson's water system.⁴ Joint Applicants proposed that Green River Valley District accomplish this by assuming **all** of Edmonson's RD debt associated with its water system, **except** for one small RD Bond: Bond Issue 2013B, having RD Loan Number 99396-41, which had an outstanding principal balance of \$134,500 as of June 15, 2026,⁵ and by paying the remainder of the 52 percent of the total debt attributable to the construction and improvement of Edmonson District's water system in cash.⁶ If the transfer proposed in this proceeding had closed on or before June 15, 2026, the estimated RD debt to be

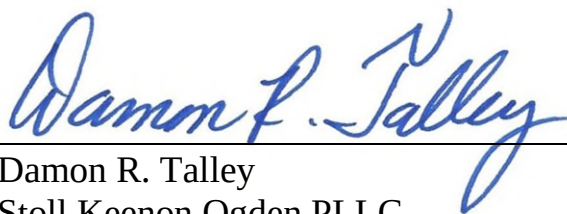
assumed was \$4,355,500 and the estimated cash due at closing would have been \$254,300.

6. Because the record of Case No. 2025-00330 and the record of this proceeding have been consolidated, Joint Applicants reasonably anticipate that Grayson County Water District (“Grayson District”) will also file a Motion for an Informal Conference. Should the Commission find it beneficial and efficient to conduct a joint informal conference involving parties from both proceedings, Joint Applicants have no objection whatsoever to that arrangement.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Joint Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant this Motion and schedule an informal conference for the purpose of Commission Staff and Joint Applicants discussing what information is potentially sufficient to fully evaluate a proposal such as the one presented in this proceeding.

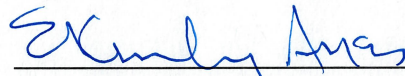
