

On October 14, 2025, Navitas KY NG, LLC (“Navitas”) submitted a rate adjustment request to the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“PSC”), and at that time mailed notice of its proposed rates to its customers. Because certain of the information contained in the original notice has since been updated, Navitas is providing this updated notice consistent with the direction of the PSC Staff.

Pursuant to the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:076, please take notice of the following information about the proposed rate adjustment that is presented below: The rates contained in this notice are proposed by Navitas, but the PSC, the state agency that regulates utility services in Kentucky, may order rates to be charged that differ from those found in this notice. The proposed rates described herein were filed with the PSC on November 7, 2025.

Please note that Navitas has also requested that the PSC grant Navitas the ability to place interim rates into effect on an emergency basis.
