**KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY’S REQUEST TO  
SUBMIT MATTER FOR DECISION ON THE RECORD**

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky’s (“Commission”) April 30, 2026 Order, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record and without a hearing. In support of its request, Kentucky Power states as follows:

The Commission opened this case and issued its original procedural schedule by order dated December 19, 2025 (“Procedural Schedule”). The Procedural Schedule set the last day to intervene in this case as January 23, 2026. As of the date of this filing, only the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky (“Attorney General”), and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (“KIUC”) moved for, and were granted, intervention in this matter. Commission Staff’s first set of data requests to Kentucky Power were included in the December 19, 2025 opening order. The Company submitted its responses to Commission Staff’s first set of data requests and provided testimony of six witnesses on January 23, 2026. Commission Staff submitted its second set of data requests and the Attorney General submitted its first set of data requests to Kentucky Power on February 6, 2026. The Company submitted its responses to the Commission Staff’s and Attorney General’s February 6, 2026 data requests on February 20, 2026. Commission Staff submitted a third set of data requests to Kentucky Power on March 5, 2026 to

which the Company responded on March 20, 2026. The Attorney General and KIUC submitted notices on March 26, 2026 that each of them does not intend to sponsor testimony in this proceeding. The Commission issued an Order on April 30, 2026 amending the original procedural schedule to require Kentucky Power to request a public hearing or submit a request for the matter to be decided based on the written record by June 1, 2026. Kentucky Power has entered into a Settlement Agreement, dated May 28, 2026, resolving the issues in this proceeding. A joint motion for approval of the Settlement Agreement has been filed contemporaneously with this request.

Kentucky Power contends that the record in this case has been sufficiently developed and, therefore, respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record as of the date of this filing. However, the Company will defer to the Commission if the Commission or Commission Staff determine that a hearing is needed or would be beneficial to supplement the record of this matter with additional evidence. In that event, the Company will make its witnesses available for any such hearing at the convenience of the Commission. The Company also is willing to attend an Informal Conference with Commission Staff and the parties to discuss any outstanding issues, any evidence submitted, or to discuss any other matters that would aid in the handling and disposition of the case.
