**MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION
ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD**

Comes now Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to submit the case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On December 19, 2025, the Commission issued an Order opening an investigation for the two-year review of East Kentucky Power Cooperative’s application of the Fuel Adjustment Clause from November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2024. The December 19, 2025 Order contained a procedural schedule that allowed for the filing of an affidavit of compliance and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. There have been no motions for intervention filed in this case. Grayson Rural Electric has until March 20, 2026, to request a hearing or state that the case should be submitted on the record.

Since there are no intervenors in this case and Grayson Rural Electric believes the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling based upon the record. Grayson Rural Electric respectfully requests a decision from the Commission based upon the existing record.

WHEREFORE, Grayson Rural Electric moves the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record.


