Kentucky Power Company’s Request To Submit Matter For Decision On The Record

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of Kentucky’s (“Commission”) December 19, 2025 Order, Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record and without a hearing. In support of its request, Kentucky Power states as follows:

The Commission opened this case and issued its procedural schedule by order dated December 19, 2025 (“Procedural Schedule”). The Procedural Schedule set the last day to intervene in this case as January 9, 2026. As of the date of this filing, no parties have requested nor been granted leave to intervene. On January 14, 2026, Commission Staff submitted its first set of data requests to Kentucky Power. The Company submitted its responses to Commission Staff’s first data requests on January 30, 2026, in conformity with the Procedural Schedule. On February 13, 2026, Commission Staff submitted its second set of data requests to Kentucky Power. The Company submitted its responses to Commission Staff’s second data requests on February 27, 2026, in conformity with the Procedural Schedule. On February 13, 2026, Kentucky Power filed a Motion for Informal Conference to discuss aspects of the Company’s application, including the need for the project, the proposed transmission line route, and the alternative solutions presented. The virtual Informal Conference was held with Commission Staff on February 27, 2026. Kentucky

Power supplemented its data requests responses to aid the Commission in its review of the Application on March 6, 2026. The Procedural Schedule provides that Kentucky Power may request a hearing or to submit this matter for a decision on the record by March 6, 2026.

The Company respectfully requests that this matter be submitted for decision on the record. However, the Company will defer to the Commission if the Commission or Commission Staff determine that a hearing is needed or would be beneficial to supplement the record of this matter with additional evidence so that the Company's application may be granted. In that event, the Company will make its witnesses available for any such hearing at the convenience of the Commission. The Company also is willing to attend another Informal Conference with Commission Staff to discuss any outstanding issues, any evidence submitted, or to discuss any other matters that would aid in the handling and disposition of the case.
