**ATTORNEY GENERAL’S RESPONSE TO THE
COMPANY’S MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME**

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, through his Office of Rate Intervention, hereby provides notice that he has no objection to the motion of Bluegrass Water Utility Operating Company’s Motion for an extension of time. However, if the extension is granted, the Attorney General requests that the remainder of the procedural schedule be amended to accommodate the delay in responses. Additional time will be needed to prepare the Attorney General’s Supplemental Data Requests and, later, the Testimony of his expert witness.

Further, should the Commission decide that the formal hearing in this matter should be rescheduled, the Attorney General notes the following conflicts. The Attorney General’s expert witness has a preexisting scheduling conflict on May 1, 2026. Further, counsel for the Attorney General has conflicts for the week of May 11-15, 2026.
