



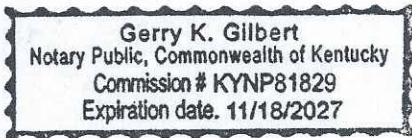

Community enjoys tractor pull at fairgrounds

The community gathered Saturday at the Mayfield-Graves County Fairgrounds for Purchase District Motor Sports Truck and Tractor Pull. Using their modified or custom-built vehicles, locals competed for payouts to see who could drag a large, weighted sled the furthest along a dirt track. The event was a grandstand attraction at the Purchase District Fair, its first tractor pull since 2019.

Delk said the fair did have to adjust due to rain. The inaugural redneck rodeo set for Tuesday is being rescheduled to a later date, and the annual Purchase District Fair Pageant will take place on June 20 at the Independence Bank Performing Arts Center.

However, she said the weather did not deter attendance and excitement for the Purchase District Fair overall.

"We needed the rain so badly, but it did affect us," Delk said. "We at least had two great nights of the fair on Friday and Saturday, which were the enduro derby and tractor pull, and the amusement attraction rides that come with the carnival were as good as ever. We're doing a lot of restructuring for the coming year, and we're really excited to do more than we have been."

Delk noted that the fair in subsequent years will return to June as it continues expansion. Meanwhile, she said the community can enjoy one final grandstand event starting at noon this Friday and Saturday.

"The upcoming horse racing is something that everyone should come to see. We're projecting to have up to 300 horses within those two days," Delk said. "We're looking at about 20 races each day. We'd really like for people to take advantage of the free admission."

Delk said the fair's success and revitalization is a result of local collaboration. To overcome the fairgrounds' "limited parking," attendees are allowed to park across the road at Graves County High School, where a shuttle transports them over roughly every half hour.

She also mentioned prominent sponsors in Jackson Purchase Medical Center and Premier Candle Corporation. Moreover, the sensory-friendly Wednesday afternoon slot for J.U. Kevil special needs children nearly doubled in attendance this year.

Delk said these partnerships help the Purchase District Fair invest back into the community. She said this flagship event not only signals the beginning of summer tourism, but it's also a major economic driver to the area.

come for the carnival, they spend money here in Mayfield and Graves County — gas, food, shopping," Delk said. "When everyone's getting out and moving around, it always seems to generate money for the community."

Delk said the goal for the Purchase District Fair is to become a regional destination for economic crossover appeal. She said new events like the "Mayfield Mayhem" wrestling exhibition and horse race cater to several industries at once while attracting new consumers. "The thing that a lot of people don't understand is we are the Purchase District Fair. We are not just a little county fair. We're hitting a lot of different avenues to help the economy" Delk said. "We're putting our heart and soul into this, and we're going to continue to grow."
