**MOTION TO CLOSE CASE AND
REMOVE FROM COMMISSION’S DOCKET**

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC” or the “Company”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) close this matter. EKPC respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 30, 2025, EKPC filed a Notice of Intent and Election and requested a case number for an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”). On the same date, the Commission assigned Case No. 2025-00415 to the proceeding.
2. Since that time there have been numerous circumstances, including Winter Storm Fern, that have caused EKPC to reconsider the timing and placement of the new generation.
3. At this time, EKPC is requesting the Commission allow this matter to be closed and removed from the Commission’s docket. In the future, when EKPC has evaluated the new generation project it will request a new docket for the application.

Wherefore, based on the foregoing, EKPC respectfully requests the Commission permit this matter to be closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
