KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 22, for an extension of time for which to respond to the following post-hearing data requests propounded by Commission Staff: KPSC PHDR 1-10, 1-11, 1-12, 1-13, and 1-15. The Commission’s July 13, 2026, procedural order requires Kentucky Power to respond to all post-hearing data requests by July 28, 2026.

Each of the identified data requests require the Company to provide correspondence and other documents relating to estimated costs for the alternatives evaluated by Kentucky Power to address the structural issues at the Mitchell Unit 2 Cooling Tower. The witness responsible for responding to these data requests is Company Witness Malone who is out of the country and, accordingly, unable to review the responses. Company Witness Malone will return to the office on Monday, July 27, 2026. Because of the volume and nature of the responses to the identified post-hearing data requests, it is unlikely that Company Witness Malone will be able to fully review and confirm that the responses are accurate and complete.

Kentucky Power therefore moves the Commission pursuant for a two-day extension of time through July 30, 2026, to file responses to KPSC PHDR 1-10, 1-11, 1-12, 1-13, and 1-15 with the Commission. Kentucky Power will timely file all other responses to data requests and attachments thereto.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company an extension of time through July 30, 2026, to file responses to KPSC PHDR 1-10, 1-11, 1-12, 1-13, and 1-15 as detailed herein; and
2. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
