Kentucky Power Company’s Motion for Extension of Time

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, for an extension of time for which to respond to parts of certain data requests propounded by Commission Staff.

Commission Staff data request KPSC 1-5(b) requests:

Explain how each item in each itemized breakdown was estimated for Option 1 and 4, and provide any documents relied on to support such estimates, including any correspondence with vendors regarding expected cost.

Commission Staff data request KPSC 1-26 requests:

Provide any correspondence regarding costs, estimates, bids, responses to requests for proposals, or other documents received from vendors or potential vendors relating to the proposed project or alternatives considered by Kentucky Power.

The Commission’s March 6, 2026, procedural order requires Kentucky Power to respond to all initial data requests by April 3, 2026.

Kentucky Power has worked diligently to identify and begin preparing all relevant responsive documents to be produced in response to KPSC 1-5(b) and 1-26. Despite Kentucky Power’s diligence and best efforts to prepare and timely file documents responsive to those requests, Kentucky Power requires additional time to review, specifically, correspondence for

responsiveness, confidentiality, and privilege, and to prepare such correspondence to be produced. Kentucky Power therefore moves the Commission pursuant to its March 6, 2026, procedural order in this case for a one-week extension of time through April 10, 2026, to file the correspondence responsive to KPSC 1-5(b) and 1-26 with the Commission. Kentucky Power is timely filing all other responses to data requests and attachments thereto, including the subparts of KPSC 1-5 that are not correspondence.

For these reasons, the Company respectfully requests a short extension of time through April 10, 2026, to file correspondence responsive to KPSC 1-5(b) and 1-26 as detailed herein.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company an extension of time through April 10, 2026, to file correspondence responsive to KPSC 1-5(b) and 1-26 as detailed herein; and
2. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
