Kentucky Power Company’s Motion for the Preparation of a Stenographic Transcription

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9)(a)(1)–(2), Kentucky Power Company respectfully asks the Commission to issue an order providing for a stenographic transcript of the hearing in this proceeding beginning July 8, 2026, to be prepared by a Commission-authorized court reporter. The Company understands that under 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9)(a)(3), it will be responsible for the cost of the transcript and having the transcript filed in the record within a reasonable time after the completion of the hearing.

The transcription will aid the parties in the briefing of this matter and may aid the Commission in its deliberations. The Company requests that the stenographic transcription be made with the court reporter present in the hearing room and not from the digital recording.

If the Company’s motion is granted, Kentucky Power will retain the services of Janine Leroux, Legal Reporting and Video, Jeffersonville, Kentucky. Ms. Leroux attended court reporting school in Sunrise, Florida from 1984 to 1986. After completing court reporting school, she began court reporting in Fort Lauderdale, West Palm Beach, and Miami, Florida for 19 years. Ms. Leroux has covered many medical malpractice trials, other trials, depositions, hearings, and arbitrations, etc. Ms. Leroux moved to Kentucky in 2005 and has been reporting here for over 20 years. She has covered several jury trials and hearings during that time. Stites & Harbison, PLLC has retained Ms. Leroux in dozens of proceedings in the last 20 years.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests the Commission enter an Order:

1. Providing for the stenographic transcription of the hearing scheduled to begin July 8, 2026, in this matter; and
2. Such further relief to which Kentucky Power may be entitled.
