Dear Ms. Bridwell:

On behalf of Carlisle County Fiscal Court and Milburn Water District, I am writing to update you on the status of our current project which will expand Milburn Water District and increase their monthly revenues.

As you are aware, in July of 2025 Carlisle County Fiscal Court was awarded \$5,000,000.00 to replace Milburn Water District water lines and expand the district to reach the Carlisle County School System, providing them with fire protection and drinking water. Bacon Farmer Workman/Marcum Engineering is the engineering firm for the project and the firm who will be overseeing the day to day construction progress on this project.

On Tuesday, March 31, 2026, a pre-construction meeting was held at the Carlisle County Courthouse where the notice to proceed was signed by Judge Executive Greg Terry and Tait Davenport, CEO of D-Port Directional Drilling, contractor for this project. Construction on this project is targeted to start mid-April, with the starting point being at State Route 307 and State Route 80, heading west into Milburn. As part of this project, all current Milburn Water District members will be receiving a new water meter and those currently not a customer, will have the option to become one as the project moves forward.

A new 75,000-gallon water tower will be constructed as phase 2 of this project. The tank site property has been purchased and Carlisle County Fiscal Court has the property deed in their possession. BFW is finalizing all permits and bid documents, which will be forwarded onto the State for approval. This phase of the project will be let for bid as soon as we receive the stamp of approval from DOW.

The total project is expected to be complete by December 2027.
