RESPONSE TO THE COMMISSION’S JANUARY 23, 2026 ORDER**

In response to the Commission’s January 23, 2026 Order, the Kentucky Broadband and Cable Association (“KBCA”), by counsel, provides the following response. In that Order, the Commission requested any objections to Kentucky Power Company’s proposed tariff on pole attachments be filed. The proposed tariff provisions appear to incorporate the provisions of 807 KAR 5:015. (“Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:015 and the terms and conditions of this Tariff, Attachments to Company Facilities that do not interfere with Company’s electric service requirements shall be permitted.”) Because the tariffs comply with the regulation, KBCA does not have any formal objections at this time.
