MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation (“Jackson Purchase”), by and through counsel, and for its motion requesting that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) amend the procedural schedule issued on April 8, 2026, in this matter. Jackson Purchase respectfully states as follows:

1. On February 12, 2026, Jackson Purchase filed its Application for approval of indebtedness pursuant to KRS 278.300.¹ On March 9, 2026, Commission Staff issued requests for information and Jackson Purchase provided responses.²

2. On April 8, 2026, the Commission issued an order extending its review of Jackson Purchase’s Application for an additional 30 days and issued a procedural schedule.³ The procedural schedule states requests for information will be issued by Commission Staff no later than April 24, 2026, and Jackson Purchase should file responses no later than May 1, 2026.

3. Meredith Kendall, Chief Financial Officer and Vice-President of Finance and Accounting at Jackson Purchase has a previously scheduled obligation where she will be out of the United States from April 16-30, 2026. Ms. Kendall has been the sole witness in this proceeding. Kendall has sponsored all Exhibits and Testimony in the Application and has responded to all requests for information. Ms. Kendall is also the employee of Jackson Purchase that has been working with the potential lenders on all financing documents. There is no other person at Jackson Purchase that can answer requests for information from Commission Staff.

4. Jackson Purchase is requesting the Commission modify the procedural schedule slightly in this proceeding. Jackson Purchase is requesting Commission Staff's and any intervenor requests be issued no later than May 1, 2026 and Jackson Purchase's responses be filed no later than May 11, 2026. Jackson Purchase will also request to submit on the record or request a Public Hearing on May 11, 2026. This modification of the procedural schedule will not prejudice the Commission or any other party that may intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Jackson Purchase respectfully requests that the Commission amend the procedural schedule and requests for information requests be issued no later than May 1, 2026, and Jackson Purchase shall file responses no later than May 11, 2026.
