**MOTION TO CLOSE CASE AND  
REMOVE FROM COMMISSION’S DOCKET**

Comes now Black Mountain Utility District (“Black Mountain), by and through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully requests the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) allow Black Mountain to withdraw the Application filed in this proceeding and close this matter. Black Mountain respectfully states as follows:

1. On February 25, 2026, Black Mountain filed an Application for an adjustment of rates pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076. The Commission accepted this matter for filing on March 11, 2026.
2. Since the filing of the Application in this matter, Black Mountain and Kentucky-American Water Company (“KAW”) have requested approval from the Commission for authorization for KAW to purchase Black Mountain’s assets.<sup>1</sup>
3. At this time, Black Mountain is requesting the Commission allow Black Mountain to withdraw the application for an adjustment of rates based upon the agreement it will sell all assets to KAW.

4. If for any reason, the Commission does not approve the transfer of Black Mountain's assets to KAW, Black Mountain will file an updated application for a rate adjustment pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076.

Wherefore, based on the foregoing, Black Mountain respectfully requests the Commission permit Black Mountain to withdraw its application and this matter to be closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
