MOTION TO SUBMIT

Comes now Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy”) and Millennium Energy, Inc. (“Millennium”) (collectively, “Joint Applicants”) by and through counsel, pursuant to the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) March 31, 2026 Order and other applicable law, and respectfully requests to submit this matter for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.

The Joint Applicants respectfully state as follows:

1. On March 11, 2026, the Joint Applicants filed an Application for authority to transfer the ownership of Millennium and its assets to Atmos Energy.¹ On March 31, 2026, the Commission issued an order establishing a schedule for the processing of the proceeding.² Commission Staff issued multiple requests for information.³ The Joint


Applicants filed responses to these requests.⁴ and Jackson Purchase provided responses.⁵ The procedural schedule set June 1, 2026, as the last day to request a hearing or submit the matter for a decision on the record.

2. The Joint Applicants believe the issues in this proceeding have been adequately addressed by the written discovery. Accordingly, the Joint Applicants do not believe a formal evidentiary hearing is necessary in this matter and move to submit the case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Joint Applicants respectfully move to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.
