**APPLICATION**

Kinetic ABS KY LLC (“Kinetic ABS”) jointly with its Kentucky incumbent local exchange carrier (“ILEC”) affiliate Windstream Kentucky East, LLC (the “ILEC Asset Transferor”),<sup>1</sup> respectfully requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) grant authority, to the extent it may be required pursuant to KRS 278.020(6), for the Applicants to complete a *pro forma* transfer of telecommunications assets and certain associated residential customers from the ILEC Asset Transferor to Kinetic ABS (the “*Pro Forma* Transfer”).

Applicants are undertaking the *Pro Forma* Transfer concurrently with a proposed financing (the “Financing Arrangement”) which will provide funding for the *Pro Forma* Transfer.<sup>2</sup> As

further described below, the *Pro Forma* Transfer easily meets the KRS 278.020(6) criteria, and will, together with the Financing Arrangement (collectively, the “Proposed Transactions”), further the public interest and promote the Applicants’ corporate purposes by benefitting the financial condition of the Applicants and their current and future subsidiaries and allowing them to become more effective competitors in the communications industry. The Proposed Transactions mirror the asset transfer and financing arrangements discussed in the September 26, 2025, Joint Application (“September Application”) and approved by the Commission on November 21, 2025 (“November Order,” together with the September Application, the “2025 Transaction”) in Case No. 2025-00319.<sup>3</sup>

In support of this filing, the Applicants provide the following information.

#### **I. DESCRIPTION OF THE APPLICANTS AND RELATED PARTIES**

Kinetic ABS is a Delaware limited liability company registered and in good standing with the Kentucky Secretary of State’s Office. Kinetic ABS is authorized to provide competitive local exchange and interexchange services in Kentucky.<sup>4</sup> Kinetic ABS is a wholly owned direct subsidiary of Kinetic ABS Issuer LLC (“Kinetic ABS Issuer”), a Delaware limited liability company formed for purposes of the Proposed Transactions. Kinetic ABS Issuer is not a telecommunications provider and does not hold any telecommunications authorizations by the Commission.

ILEC Asset Transferor Windstream Kentucky East, LLC is a Delaware limited liability company organized on October 31, 2007. It is authorized to provide local exchange services as an ILEC pursuant to Utility ID No. 5022700. Its telephone number is 800-347-1991.

As further described in Section III below, Kinetic ABS will also receive assets and associated customers, as applicable, from its Kentucky affiliates CSL Kentucky System, LLC and Windstream Communications, LLC (collectively, the “Non-ILEC Asset Transferors”). CSL Kentucky System, LLC is a CLEC authorized to provide local exchange services in Kentucky pursuant to Utility ID 5057240. Windstream Communications, LLC is an IXC authorized to provide interexchange services in Kentucky pursuant to Utility ID 5118400.

The principal offices of Applicants, the Non-ILEC Asset Transferors, and Kinetic ABS Issuer are located at 2101 Riverfront Drive, Suite A, Little Rock, Arkansas 72202. The Applicants, the Non-ILEC Transferors, and Kinetic ABS Issuer are indirect, wholly owned subsidiaries of their ultimate parent, Uniti Group Inc. (“Uniti Group”), a publicly traded Delaware corporation (NASDAQ: UNIT). While Uniti Group does not provide telecommunications services itself, it owns and manages a number of licensed subsidiaries that have on a combined basis over 100 years of experience providing telecommunications and data services to retail, wholesale, government, and enterprise customers throughout the United States, including in Kentucky.

### **III. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED TRANSACTIONS**

As in the 2025 Transaction, the Proposed Transactions are an integral part of a financing initiative by the Applicants to support continued deployment of fiber across rural and other regions of Kentucky and other states.<sup>5</sup> The financing will involve the issuance of notes with terms

exceeding 12 months secured in part by the assets of Kinetic ABS and its operating affiliates in ten other states.<sup>6</sup> Similar to the 2025 Transaction, the relevant assets, including network infrastructure and certain associated customer accounts, will be contributed to Kinetic ABS and these other affiliates through *pro forma* inter-company assignments completed concurrently with the note issuance. Additional details regarding these steps as they relate to the Applicants—the *Pro Forma* Transfer and Financing Arrangement—are below.

**A. *Pro Forma* Transfer.**

Following the same structure as the Commission approved in the 2025 Transaction, under the *Pro Forma* Transfer, the ILEC Asset Transferor and Non-ILEC Asset Transferors (collectively, the “Asset Transferors”) will assign all network facilities and electronics in the exchanges listed in **Exhibit A** (the “Asset Transfer Exchanges”), as well as residential customer accounts associated with the transferred assets, to Kinetic ABS.<sup>7</sup> Following the transfer, Kinetic ABS will own, and with support from its affiliates, operate the transferred assets and continue to offer the fiber-based services offered today by the ILEC Asset Transferor, including local exchange services, interexchange services, and unregulated services such as broadband, to the transferred customers. The Asset Transferors will retain their existing telecommunications authorizations issued by the Commission, and the ILEC Asset Transferor will continue providing all existing services to non-transferred customers, including customers served via copper technology, Lifeline customers, and non-residential customers receiving fiber-based services. Kinetic ABS and the ILEC Asset Transferor will enter into an intercompany agreement to allow the ILEC Asset Transferor to use

the relevant portions of the transferred assets needed to continue providing these services, and to transport network traffic for Kinetic ABS outside of the Asset Transfer Exchanges.

Although the ILEC Asset Transferor, Windstream Kentucky East, LLC, currently receives federal high-cost support pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") Rural Digital Opportunity Fund ("RDOF") in certain counties.<sup>8</sup> The funding and eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") obligations will remain with the affiliated ILEC, Windstream Kentucky East, LLC. The *Pro Forma* Transfer thus will have no impact on the federal high-cost universal service support.

The *Pro Forma* Transfer will have no impact on the Applicants' ownership or otherwise constitute a transfer of control of any of the Applicants. The *Pro Forma* Transfer will also be seamless to the transferred customers, who will continue to receive the same services under the same rates and terms after the transfer. The Applicants will provide notice to the transferred customers at least 30 days prior to the *Pro Forma* Transfer consistent with the Federal Communications Commission's requirements.<sup>9</sup> A sample notice is attached as **Exhibit B**.

## **B. Financing Arrangement.**

The Financing Arrangement will occur concurrently with the completion of the *Pro Forma* Transfer. Under the Financing Arrangement, Kinetic ABS Issuer will issue notes secured in part

by the guarantee and asset pledge of Kinetic ABS and certain operating affiliates in ten other states. Because Kinetic ABS will be operating as a CLEC and IXC, the Financing Arrangement does not trigger pre-approval requirements under KRS 278.300 pursuant to Administrative Case Nos. 359 and 370, which exempt CLECs and IXCs from such requirements.<sup>10</sup>

#### **IV. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL UNDER KRS 278.020(6)**

Applicants respectfully request that the Commission approve the *Pro Forma* Transfer pursuant to KRS 278.020(6) to the extent required. KRS 278.020(6) provides that the Commission shall grant approval if “the person acquiring the utility has the financial, technical, and managerial abilities to provide reasonable service.” The *Pro Forma* Transfer clearly satisfies this criteria—indeed the same entities already received approval for a similar transaction in the November Order.<sup>11</sup> Kinetic ABS is under common control with the ILEC Asset Transferor and is managed by the same experienced management team currently overseeing the ILEC Asset Transferor’s operations in Kentucky.<sup>12</sup> Following the *Pro Forma* Transfer, the Applicants will be managed by this same experienced management team and continue to provide the same services to customers, on the same rates and terms and through the same customer service, technical, and operational

personnel. The *Pro Forma* Transfer will therefore be seamless to the Applicants’ customers and will not cause any disruption to or otherwise negatively impact the customers’ services. In addition, the *Pro Forma* Transfer will allow Applicants to leverage shared infrastructure for more efficient service delivery through an expanded fiber network that will support enhanced broadband services and improved service reliability for customers across the entire footprint.

The *Pro Forma* Transfer will allow Applicants to become more effective competitors in this competitive telecommunications industry and continue to support services provided to the unserved and underserved rural areas in the state. The *Pro Forma* Transfer will strengthen the Applicants’ financial position by creating operational efficiencies synergies, enabling greater investment in network infrastructure improvements and expansion. The *Pro Forma* Transfer will also benefit the financial positions of other Uniti Group operating entities, allowing such parties to continue to effectively compete in the telecommunications market, especially against larger providers and in rural and underserved markets where competition is generally more limited.

We are writing to let you know about an upcoming administrative change to your services.

- Online, phone, and auto-pay payment methods will remain the same.

- You may choose a different provider for your local and/or long-distance service at any time. If you wish to do so before the transfer, please contact the carrier of your choice as soon as possible to avoid overlapping with the scheduled transfer date. While there is no charge for the transfer to Kinetic, another provider may charge its own installation, activation, or carrier-change fees.

**Preferred carrier freezes**

- Under Federal Communications Commission rules, any preferred carrier “freezes” you may have placed on your account to block changes to your local and/or long-distance provider will be lifted to complete this transfer.
