MOTION TO SUBMIT

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by and through counsel, pursuant to the April 23, 2026 Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and other applicable law, and for its Motion to Submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing, respectfully states as follows:

1. On April 23, 2026, the Commission established this case to review and evaluate EKPC’s environmental surcharge for the six-month period ending November 30, 2025. The Commission established a procedural schedule that allowed for written discovery. The Commission’s Order permitted EKPC to request a hearing or submit on the record on or before August 19, 2026.

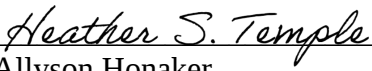
2. Commission Staff issued its First Request for Information, and EKPC provided responses on May 15, 2026. Additional requests for information were not issued to EKPC. There are no intervenors in this proceeding.

3. EKPC does not believe that a formal evidentiary hearing is necessary and moves to submit the case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record without a formal evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully moves to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.
