AFFIDAVIT OF WILLIAM A. LEWIS, VICE PRESIDENT OF OPERATIONS FOR
KENTUCKY-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY

The affiant, William A. Lewis, states and affirms as follows:

1. My name is William A. Lewis, I am the Vice President of Operations for Kentucky-American Water Company (“KAWC” or the “Company”).
2. Georgetown Municipal Water and Sewer Services (“GMWSS”) takes service from KAWC as a Sale for Resale customer pursuant to First Revised Sheet No. 29 of the Company’s Commission approved tariffs.
3. On June 2, 2026, GMWSS, moved to intervene in this rate case.
4. GMWSS attached to its motion to intervene an affidavit of GMWSS General Manager, Chase Azevedo, P.E.
5. Mr. Azevedo’s affidavit states that GMWSS purchased **2,399,200** gallons of water from KAWC in 2025 at a cost of **\$15,956**.
6. Mr. Azevedo’s affidavit also states that, since the Commission approved an increase in KAWC’s Sale for Resale rate on December 16, 2025, GMWSS has purchased **51,583,263** gallons of water from KAWC at the new rates, at a cost of **\$428,610.49**.
7. After reviewing Mr. Azevedo’s Affidavit, KAWC examined its GMWSS billing records for the two Sale for Resale GMWSS accounts to determine the reason for the substantial increase in usage and costs (“Account #1” with a service address at Cherry Blossom Way and “Account #2” with a service address at Champion Way).
8. For Account #1, KAWC’s 2025 invoices show that GMWSS purchased **3,038,000** gallons of water, for which the usage charges totaled **\$15,077.63** and the total charge was **\$19,580.99**. KAWC’s 2026 invoices through May show that GMWSS purchased **556,900** gallons of water, for which the usage charge was **\$4,627.34** and the total charge was **\$5,611.13**.

9. For Account #2, KAWC's 2025 invoices show that GMWSS purchased **2,404,400** gallons, for which the usage charge was **\$11,908.27** and the total charge was **\$16,317.54**. KAWC's 2026 invoices through May show that GMWSS purchased **1,107,400** gallons of water, for which the usage charge was **\$9,201.50** and the total charge was **\$13,039.47**.


10. In total, KAWC's 2025 invoices show that GMWSS purchased **5,442,400** gallons of water for both Accounts #1 and #2. This total is **3,043,200** gallons higher than the usage figure in Mr. Azevedo's affidavit.

11. Through May of 2026, KAWC's invoices for Accounts #1 and #2 show that GMWSS has purchased **1,664,300** gallons of water and paid water usage charges totaling **\$13,828.84** and the total cost was **\$18,650.61**. This is **49,918,963** gallons lower than the usage figure in Mr. Azevedo's affidavit. And it is **\$409,959.88** less than Mr. Azevedo's Affidavit cost amount of **\$428,610.49**.

12. To determine the source of the discrepancy between Mr. Azevedo's figures and KAWC's invoices, KAWC reviewed other service costs that GMWSS incurred between December 16, 2025 and May 19, 2026 including Other Public Authority and public fire hydrant fees (public fire hydrants are paid by the City of Georgetown) but was unable to account for the large discrepancy.

13. As part of its proposed rate adjustment, Kentucky-American seeks to increase its sale for resale rates by 5.15%, from \$8.3091 per thousand gallons to \$8.7371 per thousand gallons.

Further, the affiant sayeth naught.
