**AFFIDAVIT OF CHASE AZEVEDO, GENERAL MANAGER OF  
GEORGETOWN MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICE**

---

The affiant, Chase Azevedo, P.E., states and affirms as follows:

1. My name is Chase Azevedo. I am the General Manager of the Georgetown Municipal Water and Sewer Service (GMWSS) and have served as General Manager since May 7, 2018.

2. On June 2, 2026, the GMWSS Board of Commissioners empowered me to direct counsel to intervene and, upon becoming a party, for GMWSS participate in this matter.

3. GMWSS takes service from Kentucky-American Water (“KAWC”) under the tariffs approved by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“the Commission”).

4. GMWSS purchased 2,399,200 gallons of water from KAWC in 2025, at a cost of \$15,956.

5. On December 16, 2025, the Commission entered an Order regarding the prior application by KAWC for an adjustment of rates. *See Order, Kentucky-American Water Company, Case No. 2025-00122 (Ky. PSC Dec. 16, 2025).*

6. The Commission’s Order approved a rate adjustment for KAWC, including for the “Sales for Resale” service type under which GMWSS takes service from KAWC, and increased the “Sales for Resale” volumetric charge to \$8.3091 per thousand gallons—an increase over previous rates of \$4.9527 per thousand gallons. *See Order, at Appx. B, Kentucky-American Water Company, Case No. 2025-00122*

(Ky. PSC Dec. 16, 2025). The resulting rate approved by the Commission was higher than the rate initially proposed by KAWC (\$6.9266 per thousand gallons).

7. Since the Commission's Order approving the rate increase for KAWC on December 16, 2025, GMWSS has purchased 51,583,263 gallons of water from KAWC, at a rate of \$8.3091 per thousand gallons, for a cost to be paid of \$428,610.49.

8. Of that \$428,610.49, GMWSS is obligated to pay \$173,134.06 more for the wholesale purchase of water from KAWC since December 16, 2025—less than six months from the date of this Affidavit—than it would have prior to the Commission's approval of KAWC's last rate increase.

Further, the affiant sayeth naught.
