LYNN BARK ENERGY CENTER, LLC’S NOTICE OF INTENT

Comes now Lynn Bark Energy Center, LLC (“Lynn Bark”) by and through counsel, pursuant to KRS 278.714, 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2 and other applicable law, and does hereby tender its Notice of Intent to file an application, on or about June 5, 2026, for a Certificate to Construct a nonregulated electric transmission line in Martin County, Kentucky (the “Project”), respectfully stating as follows:

1. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(a), a forthcoming application will be filed by Lynn Bark Energy Center, LLC, 422 Admiral Boulevard, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. The applicant’s telephone number is: (816) 491-7321, and its email address is: info@lynnbarkenergycenter.com.


2. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(b), the Project is a 138 kV nonregulated electric transmission line that will be up to 6.3 miles in length. The line will run between the Lynn Bark Energy Center’s onsite substation and the existing Inez Substation, which is owned by Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”)/American Electric Power, Inc. (“AEP”).

3. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Section 2(2)(c), the Project will be located in unincorporated Martin County, Kentucky, approximately 14 miles northeast of the town of Prestonburg. The Lynn Bark Energy Center is located on 1,514 acres of land off Davella Road, near Debord, Martin County, Kentucky. Its latitude/longitude coordinates are 37.791377N,-82.548047W. No portion of the Project is located within the boundaries of any municipality.

4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:110, Sections 2(2)(d), (e), and (f), there is no planning or zoning commission with jurisdiction over the site and no local setback requirements apply to the Project. Upon information and belief, no statutory setbacks apply to the Project.
