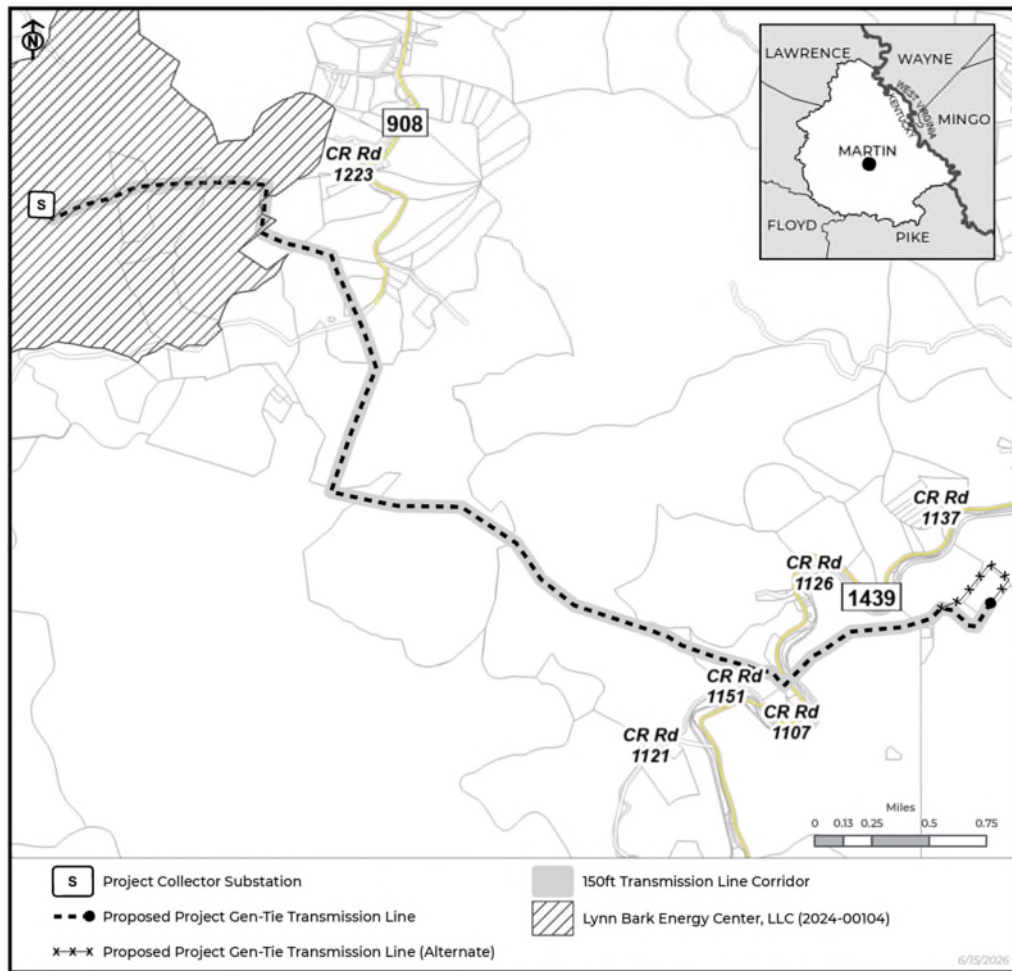

## Lynn Bark Energy Center Notice of Application for Transmission Line

Lynn Bark Energy Center, LLC (“Lynn Bark”) is proposing to build a 138 kV nonregulated transmission line (“Line”) approximately 6.3 miles in length. The Line will connect the approved up-to-200 megawatt Lynn Bark merchant solar electric generating facility’s onsite substation to the existing Inez Substation, which is owned by East Kentucky Power/American Electric Power (see Siting Board Case No. 2024-00104).

The Line will be located in unincorporated Martin County, approximately 14 miles northeast of the town of Prestonburg. A map of the Line’s proposed route and an alternate route is provided below:
