Comes now Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Taylor County”), by and through counsel, pursuant to the April 28, 2026 Order, of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and other applicable law, and moves to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing, and respectfully state as follows:

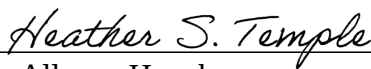
1. On April 28, 2026, the Commission issued a procedural schedule in this proceeding. Taylor County filed responses to Commission Staff’s First Request for Information on May 27, 2025. Taylor County filed responses to additional discovery requests on June 24, 2026. The April 28, 2026 Order requires the parties to request or waive a hearing on June 29, 2026.

2. Taylor County believes the issues in this proceeding have been adequately addressed through the written discovery. Taylor County does not believe a formal evidentiary hearing is necessary and moves to submit the case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record without a formal evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, Taylor County respectfully moves to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.
