As such, Peach Strudel Bread was baked en masse. It has a nice crumb, a delicious taste, and a nice strudel topping covering it.

Homemade Peach Strudel Bread.

2 Tbs Butter

Bread:

- 2 cups Flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp baking soda
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1 egg
- 3/4 cups sugar
- 1/3 cup oil (or apple-sauce)
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 2 cups peaches
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp ground cardamon

Topping: Combine ingredients using a fork or a pastry cutter to mix until crumbs form.

Bread:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, spices and salt in medium bowl.

In a large bowl, mix egg and sugar until combined

Add peaches, oil, milk and vanilla to the egg and sugar combination.

Add dry ingredients to wet, mixing until combined. Do not overmix.

Pour into a 9x5 well-greased loaf pan.

Sprinkle topping on batter.

Bake for 60 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean

Cool before serving.
