

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-05-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE WEST SHELBY WATER DISTRICT ADJUSTING
WATER RATES AND CHARGES TO OFFSET THE
LOUISVILLE WATER COMPANY AND THE SHELBYVILLE
MUNICIPAL WATER & SEWER COMMISSION WHOLESALE
RATE INCREASES**

WHEREAS, the Louisville Water Company (“LWC”) and the Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission (“SMW&SC”) are West Shelby Water District’s (“District”) wholesale water providers;

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2026, LWC filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“PSC”) seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that LWC charges the District from \$2.79 to \$2.88 per 1,000 gallons and seeking to increase the monthly meter fees that LWC charges the District (See PSC Case TFS2026-00118), effective July 1, 2026;

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2026, SMW&SC filed an application with the PSC seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that SMW&SC charges the District at the Finchville Master Meter at Clark Station Road from \$2.89 to \$2.98 per 1,000 gallons (See PSC Case TFS2026-00206), effective June 19, 2026;

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2026, SMW&SC filed an application with the PSC seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that SMW&SC charges the District at all other master meters from \$2.62 to \$2.69 per 1,000 gallons (See PSC Case TFS2026-00206), effective June 19, 2026;

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from LWC and SMW&SC during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to the District will be **\$31,194.97**

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with LWC and SMWS&C's wholesale rate increases; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for the District to increase its water rates commensurate with LWC and SMW&SC's wholesale rate increases via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA").

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEST SHELBY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. the PWA factor is **\$0.10** per 1,000 gallons.

Section 3. All tiers of water usage set forth in the District's existing tariff shall be increased by **\$0.10** per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of the District shall be as set forth in **Appendix A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates and charges set forth in **Appendix A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates and charges shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after July 15, 2026.

Section 5. The Office Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Office Manager, all appropriate District Staff, and the District's attorney are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
