**Kentucky Power Company’s Motion for Leave to Deviate**

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22 for leave to deviate from the filing requirements set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2), allowing it to file its Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Application”) one day after filing its June 11, 2026, Notice of Intent and Election.

Kentucky Power acted in good faith and with due care in arranging for the timely filing of the Notice of Intent and Election on June 11, 2026. On June 12, 2026, however, the Company identified its oversight in the timing requirements for the Company to apply for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (“CPCN”) to bid on a franchise to use the streets and rights-of-way of the City of Prestonsburg for the provision of retail electric services. Immediately upon learning of this oversight, the Company prepared the application for a CPCN filed contemporaneously with this motion. In order to allow the Commission as much time as possible to review the Company’s Application and to allow the Company to meet the schedule established by the City of Prestonsburg, the Company seeks leave to deviate from the seven-day requirement set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2).

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company a deviation from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(2); and
2. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
