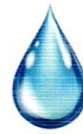

This increase is a result of Owensboro Municipal Utilities' rate increase to our wholesale rate. The water rate attributed to your system will increase from \$ 4.17 per 1,000 gallons to \$ 4.37 per 1,000 gallons. This rate will become effective for water purchased after June 1, 2026 and will not appear on your bill until the end of July billing.

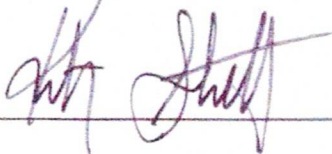

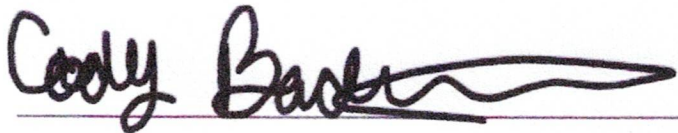

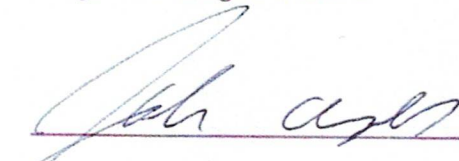
