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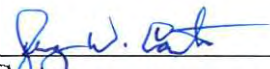

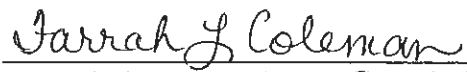

Commission Staff's First Request for Information**

Request 1: Refer to the letter to the PSC Executive Director (Letter). Explain how the proposed changes to the Rate H – Wholesale Renewable Energy Program (Rate H) tariff will impact Inter-County Energy's existing Option B customers.

Response 1: Inter-County Energy currently has two members eligible for service under Rate H, Option B: Diageo and Maker's Mark. However, neither member is currently being billed under Rate H, Option B. Cooperative Solar Farm 3, which will support Diageo's renewable energy goals, is currently under construction but has not yet been placed into service. Although Maker's Mark's solar facility is operational, Inter-County Energy has not received a bill from EKPC reflecting the credit. After receiving a bill from EKPC, Inter-County will then apply the credits. The future impact will be limited to the calculation of the credit issued to each member, which will be based on the Locational Marginal Price ("LMP") rather than the lesser of EKPC's avoided cost or the LMP, pending Commission approval of this requested change to the LMP.

Request 2: Refer to the Letter. Explain how Inter-County Energy treats the current Rate H Option B agreements during the billing period.

Response 2: Because EKPC has not billed Inter-County Energy for either facility, Inter-County Energy has not billed either member under Rate H, Option B. Inter-County Energy will continue billing each member under its existing arrangement until the applicable facility is fully operational and EKPC begins billing Inter-County Energy for that facility.

Request 3: Refer to Inter-County Energy's P.S.C. KY. No. 8, Revision 5, Sheet No. 44.1. Refer also to East Kentucky Power Cooperative's (EKPC) Rate H – Wholesale Renewable Energy Program, P.S.C. No. 35, Third Revised Sheet No. 38. EKPC's tariff does not currently exclude Option B customers from the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) and environmental surcharge. Explain and reconcile this discrepancy in language.

Response 3: Inter-County Energy developed its tariff to align with EKPC's proposed tariff. However, following additional discussions with EKPC, Inter-County Energy determined that the Fuel Adjustment Clause, Environmental Surcharge, and Total Credits provisions should also be revised. Please refer to EKPC's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information, Item 1, for additional detail. Following the conclusion of this proceeding, Inter-County Energy will file revised tariff sheets with the Commission.
