Alternative Rate Filing Adjustment

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Enclosed for filing in the referenced case is Green-Taylor Water District (GTWD) application for an adjustment to its water rates. This ARF application is being filed pursuant to 807 KAR 5:076 and uses calendar year 2025 as the test year with appropriate adjustments to normalize revenue and expenses.

GTWD experienced 28.35% water loss in the test year and accepts that adjustments to expenses are required due to water loss being greater than the allowable 15% level. GTWD calculates a reduction of \$180,691 in expenses to be recovered in its application for rates. GTWD requests in this application that the PSC approve a monthly Water Loss Reduction Surcharge (WLRS) of \$2.76 per customer for a period of 48 months. GTWD states that it has been working to reduce line loss and believes that the funds generated from the WLRS will provide additional resources needed to further its efforts. GTWD purchases all its water and reducing water loss will have a significant impact on GTWD finances.

Green-Taylor Water District customers currently read their own meters monthly. The GTWD board voted on the July 7, 2026, to purchase approximately 500 new meters. The meters will be compatible with a cellular AMI system. The district's plan is to replace its manual read meters with a cellular AMI system. Approximately 4% of GTWD system will need to be AMR meters once the system is completed. Additionally, the board approved the hiring of three new employees to read its customers' meters. The hiring is a necessary interim step to ensure accurate meter readings for all GTWD customers while the systems meters are replaced.

Green-Taylor Water District requests the Public Service Commission, in its final order regarding this matter grant an effective date on the first of the month of the next billing cycle from when the adjustment in rates is approved.
