Bowling Green Municipal Utilities (BGMU) plans to file, no later than August 1, 2026, a proposed rate schedule which will change the rates for water and sewer service provided to Warren County Water District (WCWD) as follows:

The proposed effective date is September 1, 2026.

WCWD purchased 3,454,302,372 gallons of water from Bowling Green Municipal Utilities during the Test Year (FYE June 30, 2025). Its average monthly purchases were 287,858,531 gallons, of which 21,293,198 gallons were at the \$2.4086 per thousand gallons rate; 171,766,167 gallons were at the \$2.3135 per thousand gallons rate; 25,167 gallons were at the \$2.5265 per thousand gallons rate; and 94,774,000 gallons were at \$2.3731 per thousand gallons rate. Under the current rates, WCWD's average monthly bill was \$673,640. Under the proposed rate effective September 1, 2026, WCWD's average monthly bill will be \$927,603, for an increase of \$253,964 per month or 37.7%.

WCWD purchased 1,197,712,000 gallons of sewer collection services from Bowling Green Municipal Utilities during the Test Year (FYE June 30, 2025). Its average monthly purchases were 99,809,333 gallons at \$3.1285 per thousand gallons. Under the current rates, WCWD's average monthly bill was \$312,253.50. Under the proposed rate effective September 1, 2026, WCWD's average monthly bill will be \$364,304.07, for an increase of \$52,050.57 per month or 16.7%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Bowling Green Municipal Utilities. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Commission does not receive a timely written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial mailing of the notice, the Commission may take final action on the tariff filing.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
WARREN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ADJUSTING SEWER
RATES TO OFFSET BOWLING GREEN MUNICIPAL
UTILITIES SEWAGE TREATMENT RATE INCREASE**

WHEREAS, Bowling Green Municipal Utilities (“BGMU”) provides sewage treatment service for Warren County Water District (“District”);

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2026, BGMU filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“PSC”) seeking to increase the sewage treatment rate that BGMU charges the District as set forth in BGMU’s Notice to the District dated July 17, 2026. (See PSC Case TFS2026-00356);

WHEREAS, based upon the sewage treated by BGMU during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to the District will be **\$605,835**;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with BGMU’s sewage treatment rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:075 provide the legal mechanism for the District to increase its sewer rates commensurate with BGMU's sewage treatment rate increase via a Treated Sewer Adjustment ("TSA");

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WARREN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The TSA factor is **\$0.40** per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of sewer usage set forth in the District's existing tariff shall be increased by **\$0.40** per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly sewer rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the sewer collection system of the District shall be as set forth in **Appendix A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates and charges set forth in **Appendix A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates and charges shall be in effect for all sewer service rendered on and after September 1,

2026.

Section 5. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the TSA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The General Manager, all appropriate District Staff, and the District's attorney are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the TSA.

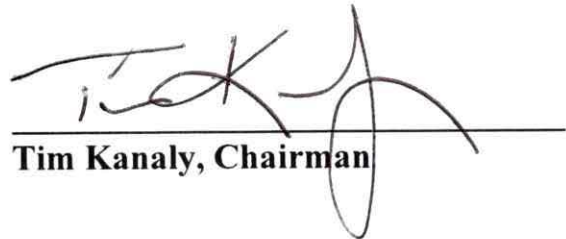
Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
