In connection with the acquisition of Tritel's parent company, AT&T Wireless, by Cingular Wireless, Tritel was converted to a limited liability company. The Agreement is currently with Tritel Communications, LLC, which is now a part of the Cingular Wireless family. Tritel and South Central RTC agree that the Agreement shall cover Tritel's wireless operating affiliates, including New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC.

Billing

The Agreement is now a part of the new, combined Cingular. For some period of time, Cingular will operate under the Agreement with the OCNs of both Cingular and AWS

(listed below).

A portion of Cingular's network (OCN 6207) currently lacks the capability to measure terminating traffic from Carrier, while another portion of Cingular's network (OCN 6010) can measure such terminating traffic. Reciprocal compensation billing between Carrier and the new, combined Cingular will occur as follows. Carrier will issue separate bills for OCN 6010 and Cingular OCN 6207 based upon records received from the transiting carrier or other records produced through Carrier's ability to measure Cingular-originated traffic terminated on Carrier's network.

The bills for OCN 6010 will be based upon terminating measurements. The bills for the OCN 6207 will be based upon the traffic ratio factor set out in the Agreement.


