Dear Jancine Tremblay:

In accordance with the timeframe stated within Terms and Conditions of the contract, on May 17, 1999, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. expressed its interest to LogicSouth, Inc. in commencing the renegotiations of the Interconnection Agreement between the two Parties. The basis for the renegotiations has been the current BellSouth Standard Interconnection Agreement. This Standard Agreement is utilized so that the new agreement might reflect the various changes established by court orders, along with recent developments in industry standards, subsequent to signing the original agreement.

The renegotiations process did not progress during the negotiations window. I contacted LogicSouth, Inc. on May 18, 2001, June 15, 2001, July 16, 2001, August 14, 2001, September 13, 2001 via mail, and I also made several telephone attempts, none of which I received a response.

Additionally, as of May 16, 2001, the term of the existing Agreement between the two Parties expired. LogicSouth, Inc. has not stated its preference to retain the existing Agreement and has further declined to negotiate any modifications towards a new Agreement. Lastly, the extension of the arbitration window that BellSouth agreed to in good faith lapsed on October 28, 2001.

Our records show that LogicSouth, Inc. never established a Q account. Due to the inactivity, please be informed that the Interconnection Agreement between the Parties **will be terminated as of December 29, 2001**, 60 days from the issuance of this letter.
