I would like to correct one matter in my letter dated October 16, 2006. That letter stated we would request the testimony of our case-in-chief witnesses to be stipulated to by the other parties. After discussing this matter with Commission Staff and the other parties, my understanding is that the parties will <u>not</u> stipulate to the admission of our case-in-chief testimony.
