MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME OF BELLSOUTH
TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. D/B/A AT&T KENTUCKY

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky (“AT&T Kentucky”), by counsel, respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) for an extension of time in which to file Direct Testimony and Rebuttal Testimony in this case.

The Commission’s Order dated June 2, 2009, requires Direct Testimony to be filed July 14, 2009, and Rebuttal Testimony to be filed August 4, 2009. 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
