O R D E R

On June 2, 2009, the Commission issued a procedural schedule in the dispute between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.¹ and Brandenburg Telephone Company (“Brandenburg Telephone”). The June 2, 2009 Order required the parties to file direct testimony on or before July 14, 2009 and to file rebuttal testimony on or before August 4, 2009. On June 26, 2009, AT&T Kentucky filed with the Commission a motion to amend the procedural schedule to allow additional time to file direct testimony and rebuttal testimony. AT&T Kentucky states that the request is not made for the purpose of delay and states, as grounds for its motion, that, on July 14, 2009, counsel for AT&T Kentucky will be involved in another proceeding before the Commission and will be unable to prepare the testimony for filing. Counsel for Brandenburg Telephone has agreed to the proposed extension.

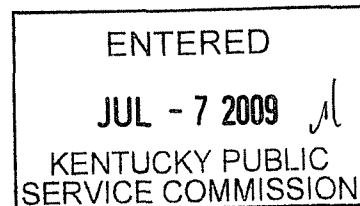
The Commission finds that the proposed extension appears reasonable and good cause exists to grant AT&T Kentucky's motion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. Direct testimony of all witnesses shall be filed with the Commission and served on all parties no later than July 24, 2009.
