

UNFAIR, UNJUST, AND UNREASONABLE**


Brandenburg Telephone Company, Duo County Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., Highland Telephone Cooperative, Inc., Mountain Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., North Central Telephone Cooperative Corporation, South Central Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., and West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. (collectively, the "RLECs"), by counsel, hereby reply in support of their motion to amend the existing procedural order in this matter, filed on June 8, 2009. In support of their reply, the RLECs state as follows.

Factual disagreements aside, it appears that the parties agree that a modification of the supplemental and rebuttal testimony deadlines is appropriate. Windstream has informed the

RLECs that the RLECs' expert witness will by e-mail on Friday, June 12, 2009, receive complete responses to his questions regarding Windstream's cost support data. Windstream has also informed the RLECs that it will make its witness available to answer questions from the RLECs' witness regarding the responses that will be e-mailed this afternoon. In light of these representations, the RLECs have no objection to the June 23 and July 15, 2009 dates counterproposed by Windstream.

Accordingly, the RLECs respectfully request that the Commission amend the existing procedural order by extending the deadlines to file supplemental testimony to June 23, 2009 and rebuttal testimony to July 15, 2009.


