Rick -

The Commission approved LG&E Rate RRP in Case No. 2007-00117 on July 12, 2007. In that case, LG&E had requested, and the Commission approved, that the rate would be restricted to up to 100 residential customers. LG&E now has 98 residential customers on Rate RRP. We are currently working with GE on a program that may provide additional opportunities for energy savings whereby up to 15 GE employees would receive appliances from GE that are designed to respond according to the particular pricing period that is underway. GE would like for those GE employees (who would have to live in the vicinity of the LG&E designated routes) to be eligible for service under Rate RRP. We would like to be in a position to put these GE employees on the RRP rate as quickly as possible. I am writing for your advice on the quickest way to try and accomplish this from a regulatory perspective. I appreciate your time, and please let me know if you need any additional information. Thanks.
