When we received the original letter for the water upgrade, which everyone wants desperately, it was stated that they were in the process of getting grants, and that we should be able to do the surcharge.

Could you please help us with this matter. We would greatly appreciate the assistance. We have been wanting water for a very long time. We only recently received sewage which also cost a lot of money. As I stated, no one can really afford nearly \$8,000 up front.
