Dear Counselors:

The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on December 1, 2008 on behalf of E.ON U.S. LLC, Western Energy Corp., and LG&E Energy Marketing, Inc., (collectively "E.ON Entities") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential under Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870 et. seq. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as certain information filed in the E.ON Entities' updated response to Data Request No. 83 of the Attorney General's Initial Request for information dated February 1, 2008. Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the information is confidential and proprietary information relevant to the financial conditions affecting an unregulated entity, similar to information previously granted confidentiality by the Commission on February 14, 2008 in a letter in the above captioned case.

Based on a review of the information, the Commission has determined that the information for which you seek confidential treatment is such as to be authorized to be withheld from public inspection under KRS 61.878 and Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001. The information has been determined to be of a confidential and proprietary nature,

which if openly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to your client's competitors if publically available from the Commission's records. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential meets the criteria for confidential protection and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.

If the information becomes publically available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, the E.ON Entities are required by Section 8(9)(a) of 807 KAR 5:001 to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
