

LOCAL EXCHANGE TARIFF

4. In accordance with KRS 278.548, TRS shall be available state-wide for all ready center calls originating and terminating within Kentucky, but shall not include interstate calls.

The Kentucky Telecommunications Relay Service will handle most calls normally handled over the regular telephone network (except "900" and "976" numbers). These include calls that are dialed direct, billed to a third number, collect, person to person, AT&T, and LEC calling card.

5. The amount of the TRS surcharge is .02 cents per month per "access line". In addition to the TRS surcharge there will be a surcharge of .02 cents per month per access line for the funding of the Telecommunications Access R (TAP) Program. Local rates, if any, will apply. Long distance calls will be charged as normal. Long distance calls will be rated from the originating point to the terminating point of the call and will receive a discount in addition to other applicable discounts.
