
Dear Mr. Derouen:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky that Brandenburg Telephone Company ("Brandenburg Telephone") has notified Sprint Nextel and Sprint Communications Co., L.P. (collectively, "Sprint") that Brandenburg Telephone will cease providing switched access services to Sprint, effective on March 19, 2009, absent Sprint's payment of all undisputed, unpaid balances prior to that date.
